## 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Declarations of Interest:

3. **MILLENNIUM GREEN** – to consider spending of NHB monies (£8,273) and s106 Monies (£6,801) – total of £15,074 on a climbing frame (£13,459 including installation costs) and 2 picnic tables with wheelchair access, made from re-cycled materials (£876 for the 2 plus installation costs of approx. £300 each) – total of £14,935. **This will be subject to public consultation with parishioners**
4. **DRAFT BUDGET** - to consider the draft budget for 2021/22 circulated to Cllrs and the impact any loan repayments for the church wall repairs would have on the Defford & Besford Parish Council element of council tax payments
